The following statements are what I would like to have added to the CCR:

I would like to have an anlysis of these possible solutions presented to the CCB.

A nightly operation executing from your domain that would logon to each centers computer and download the data necessary for the screening of all items from NPDMS. Concatenate the data and place it on your server along with a way to discern Stvenson Wydler items. This method would provide the customer (Screener) one of the most efficient ways to obtain the data. There should be different ways to request the data and from different areas. (We might want to look at the way other agencies do their screening web pages.)

Another method is that each center have there own web page and when the customer accesses your web page (a central point) you have a search engine search each of these web pages and provide the user with a consolidated list of the information requested.

There is some software that will allow a search from a web page to access information real time from many databases at different locations. When the customer accesses your web page and requests specific information your page would access the centers NPDMS databases (real time) and provide the requested information.

There should be a way for the customer to see what is available at each center. This will suffice for the requirement that each center be able to screen the rest of NASA.
